Useful Phrases for Travel

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Useful ways to express yourself while traveling:

Yo tengo = I have

Yo no tengo = I don't have

Yo voy = I go

Yo voy a = I'm going to

Vamos = Let's go /we go

Vamos a = Let's go to/we'll go to

Hay = There is/there are

No hay = There isn't/there aren't

Yo necesito = I need

Yo no necesito = I don't need

Yo quiero = I want

Yo no quiero = I don't want

Yo prefiero = I prefer

Me da igual = It's all the same to me

Yo puedo = I can

Yo no puedo = I can't

Estoy = I am (feeling/location)

Ex: Estoy en el taxi. Estoy en el restaurante. Estoy feliz ☺.

Es = it is, he/she is

Tengo hambre = I'm hungry

Tengo sed = I'm thirsty

Tengo calor = I'm hot

Tengo frío = I'm cold

Me duele el estómago/la cabeza =

my stomach hurts/my head hurts

Por favor = Please

De nada = You're welcome

Muchas gracias = Thank you very much

Useful sayings while traveling:

¡Hay un problema! = There is a problem!

No hay problema = There isn't a problem

Está bien = It's okay

Lo siento = I'm sorry

¿Disculpe? = Excuse me? (to get someone's attention)

¡Genial! = Great!

¡Excelente! = Excellent!

Buenos días = good morning

Buenas tardes = good afternoon

Buenas noches = good evening

¿Cómo está? = How are you?

Estoy bien = I'm good.

¿Y usted? = And you?

¿Cómo se llama? = What's your name?

Me llamo = My name is

Mucho gusto = It's nice to meet you

¿Dónde está...? = Where is...

¿Cuánto cuesta? = How much does it cost?

¿Qué es? = What is this?

¿Cómo se dice...? = How do you say...

¿Qué hora es? = What time is it?

¿A qué hora? = At what time?

Hoy = today

Mañana = tomorrow

Ayer = yesterday

Día = day

Semana = week

Mes = month
